Must hold a bachelors in the field of Engineering and technology (for M.Sc. candidates with GPA of at least 3.5/5.0 or 3.2/4.0 depending on the grading system of the university.

Must hold a Masters in the field of Engineering and technology (for PhD candidates with GPA of at least 3.5/5.0 or 3.2/4.0 or show a list of publications for those who did their master by full research) depending on the grading system of the university.
